### LDS Account VS FamilySearch Account


- LDS Account—See Temple Ordinances
- Can Turn Off Ordinance Display in Settings After Signing In
- FamilySearch Account—No LDS Information Displayed
  - Will not be contacted by the church

### Information about Living Individuals


- Currently only you can see the information you enter or upload about living people
- Privacy laws govern what can and can't display
- Upon death of an individual, records can be combined so that all can see all information available






































- On Blue Name or PERSON Opens Individual Page in a New Tab


#### Who should we do temple work for?
