## Finding your relationship to an ancestor using RelativeFinder.org

## **Preparation:**

• Sign in to https://familysearch.org/

## Setting up an account:

- 1) Go to https://www.relativefinder.org/#/main
- 2) (Fun thing: Relative Finder says how many people are in your family tree and how many generations the farthest line goes back)
- 3) Hover over the "Groups" tab
- 4) Click "Create a Group" in the dropdown menu
- 5) Fill out the information for your "My Ancestors" account. Click the Private Group button.

## Accessing your new account to find relationships and pedigrees

- 1. Hover over the "Groups" Tab
- 2. Click "Manage My groups" in the dropdown menu
- 3. Click "View" on your group
- 4. Your group should show you as the only member
- 5. Go to Family Search, find an ancestor who is a child many generations back and copy their PID number
- 6. Click "Add Group Member"
- 7. Paste the PID number of the ancestor you want to know the relationship for in the "Enter the PID" box
- 8. Click the "Search" button
- 9. Click the "Add This Person" button
- 10. Click the "View All Relationships" button
- 11. Note the "Report Table" options above the group members names
- 12. "Relation to the Ancestor" shows all of your common ancestors
- 13. "Relation to Each Other" show your relationship to the person
- 14. "Mother Father Chain" shows the gender of the pedigree line

Go play with your ancestors. When you are lost, use this to create a map to find a relationship. You will sometimes be related through many different people and pedigrees.
