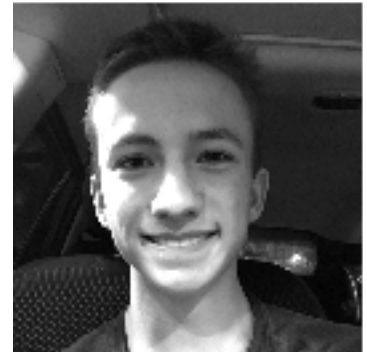

Safeguard Against Temptations

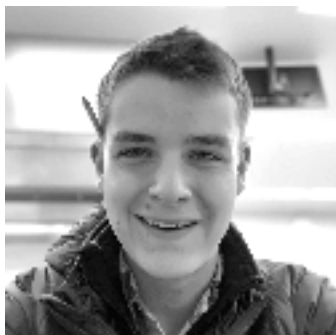
Elder David A Bednar: "Very simply, the Spirit of Elijah is the Holy Ghost.

The Spirit of Elijah will influence anyone who is involved in this work.

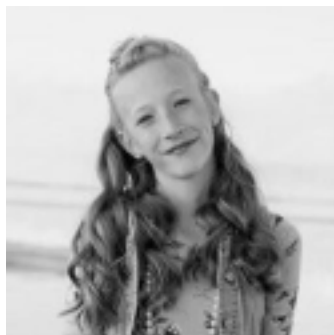
